

## Historical Characteristics

- A Cedar shingle siding above clapboard siding on North and South walls
- B Double hung window muntin patterning (4 x 2 divided top-sash only)
- C Decorative roof supports
- D Arch entry
- E Glass entry door (4 x 5 divided lites)
- F Fireplace chimney
- G Half-hip composition shingle Roof










- A Back of fireplace is covered with gypsum wall and used as mechanical plenum space
- B There is a record of the original fireplace at the current location. However, the existing fireplace and hearth were rebuilt in 1980.
- C Top of fireplace is also covered with gypsum wall and condition of fireplace behind the gypsum wall is unknown.
- D Firebox opening is currently covered due to safety concern





- A Original beams and purlins with wood board ceiling
- B 2 x 4 troffer florescent light fixtures mounted under beams
- C East entry panel door (doesn't match to the original door in 1923)

## Proposed Design

#### **Review Items**

- A Half-hip Roof
- B Energy efficient windows to match existing windows
- C Arch entry & decorative roof supports, remain
- D New glass entry door (4 x 5 divided lites)

- A Arch entry & decorative roof supports, remain as is.
- B New glass entry door (4 x 5 divided lites) to match original entry door
- C Existing Plaque to remain
- D Existing Historical Commission Sign to remain
- E Existing windows to be replaced with energy efficient windows to match existing windows in appearance



- A Fireplace to be visible through glass for children's safty indication of presence of fireplace.
- B Gypboard wall to be added in front of existing fireplace arrangement of original space is maintained.
- C AV display will be mounted on gypsum furred wall functional requirement to accommodate children's program.
- D Existing gypsum wall to remain


