Call to Order

Approval of Meeting Minutes

Secretary Johnson moved, and Commissioner Bacon seconded approval of the October 27, 2020, meeting minutes as presented. The motion was approved unanimously.

Election of Officers

Chair St. Clair moved, and Secretary Johnson seconded the appointment of Commissioner Bacon as Chair of the Camano Island Library Capital Facility Area Governing Body for 2022. Secretary Johnson moved, and Chair Bacon seconded the appointment of Commissioner St. Clair as Secretary of the Camano Island Library Capital Facility Area Governing Body for 2022.

Approval of Resolution 2021-01

Commissioner Johnson moved, and Secretary St. Clair seconded approval of Resolution No. 2021-01: a resolution of the Governing Body of Camano Island Library Capital Facility Area, authorizing the excess tax levy of \$264,600, to be levied upon all the taxable property in the CILCFA for collection in 2022; and further, that the Treasurer of Island County, Washington, is hereby authorized and requested to deposit in the CILCFA Bond Fund (Fund No. 781) all funds received from the collection of said levy. The motion was approved unanimously.
