With a Sno-Isle library card or student account, you and your students have access to eBooks, audiobooks, comics, and more.

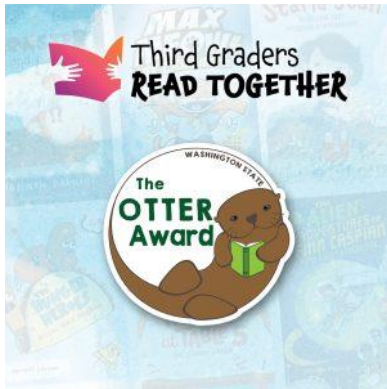
Explore resources for expanding your classroom library and encouraging your students to read in different formats.

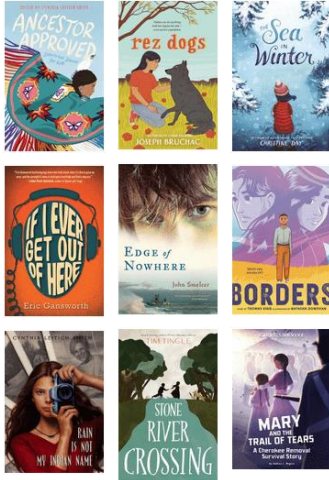
